



Whale Watching

Description:

The tour is guided by experts from Birch Aquarium at Scripps. Proceeds from each tour help support Birch Aquarium at Scripps' education and conservation programs. In addition to California gray whale adults and calves, you could also see finback whales, blue whales, humpback whales, minke, killer, and false killer whales. Additionally, you could see pods of hundreds of dolphins including rissos, common and white sided, and other marine life such as sea lions and a variety of coastal birds.
