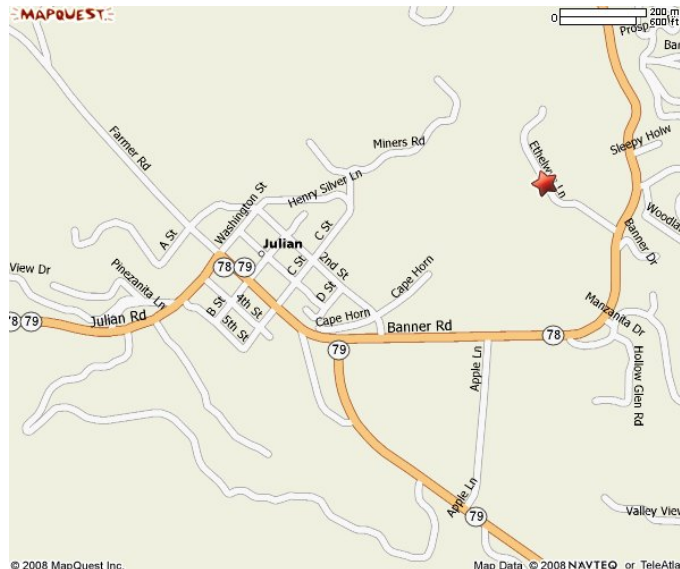

This is an outdoor program, so here are a couple of hints as to how you can best prepare:

- Wear comfortable tennis shoes or boots that can get dirty. (No open-toed shoes or sandals, please.)
- Come dressed in pioneer clothing if you can -- it makes it more fun! (Suggestions: bonnets, aprons, long skirts, vests, cowboy hats, bandanas, denim pants & shirts, and coonskin caps are all welcome.)
- Wearing long pants or long skirts is important for rugged pioneer play and when kneeling on the ground. (No shorts, please.)
- Shirts or blouses need to have sleeves.
- Bring a light jacket along in the car, just in case it gets chilly.
- Wear a hat and/or sunblock.
- Bring a sack lunch with a disposable drink. (Water is also available at drinking fountains.)



**Directions to Smith Ranch:**

Smith Ranch is located in Julian, CA, just west of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints' Julian church building.

- Drive East on Hwy. 78 from Julian and turn left onto Ethelwyn Lane.
- Turn left up the driveway to the Julian L.D.S. Church building at 2353 Ethelwyn Lane.
- Turn left into the Church's parking lot and drive down to the lower end.
- Drive through the open Smith Ranch gateway onto Smith Ranch and park in the field near the windmill. Cheerful Smith Ranch tour guides will greet you at the windmill to begin your adventure.
