EXHIBITS: Enjoy seven exhibit galleries that are centers of scientific phenomena where "hands-on" and "do touch" interactive exhibits provide a unique self-guided learning experience for all ages. This includes the new exhibit, "Earth Exposed!". Come face-to-face with erupting geysers, crumbling mountains and wind driven waves at this exhibition dedicated to the science of the natural world! Nature is a work in progress and this collection of more than 30 exhibits will place you up-close and hands-on with many of the fundamental forces that continually shape and re-shape the planet.

IMAX: FORCES OF NATURE. Showcasing the awesome spectacle of earthquakes, volcanoes and severe storms, this film follows scientists as they go on ground-breaking quests to understand how these natural disasters are triggered. This film complements the "Earth Exposed" exhibition. Recommended for Grades 4-12; however all are welcome to attend based parental discretion.
