CLUB-HOP NON-STOP

Kick it all night to the sounds that move you. We're bringing down the house with live concerts and your favorite Latin, Hip-Hop, Top 40 and Dance music stations pumpin' throughout the park.

GUESTS

Graduates may invite one guest. The guest must be at least a freshman in high school and no older than 21 years of age. Participating guest is required to pay the full fee and submit a signed Guest Contract with payment. All GSDA students must fill out a Field Trip Reservation form and list their guest on it and submit payment for them.

BEHAVIOR

Graduates and their guests are expected to behave appropriately. Students or guests behaving inappropriately will be removed by the staff member in charge of the event. Parents will be contacted and required to pick up their son or daughter immediately.

DRESS TO IMPRESS

We've got your back, and to make things run smoothly, everyone and their belongings will be searched before entering the Park. **A school representative will also be searching everyone's belongings (bags and pockets) before entering the bus.** Here are the things that need to be left at home:

- Spike jewelry / belts
- Bags / Backpacks larger than 8.5" X 11"
- Apparel with logos larger than the size of your fist
- Any home made / custom T-shirts (i.e. Class of 10)
- Clothing affiliated with schools, sports teams, clubs
- Jerseys
- Letterman Jackets
- Costumes

- Head wear (Hats (including Disney), sock hats, bandanas)
- All food (candy, gum, mints, chips, etc.)
- All fluids (water, drinks, perfume, lotion, etc.)
- Glass containers
- Alcohol and any controlled substance
- Non-prescription medication (aspirin, vitamins, etc.)
- Contact solution / eye drops larger than 4 oz. (120mL)
- Tobacco products
- Tobacco related items (lighter, matches, etc.)
- Weapons
- Markers
- Pens
- Pencils
- Laser pointers
- Aerosol Cans

Items that are OK

- Flip flops / Sandals
- Purses, bags, backpacks smaller than 8.5" X 11"
- Apparel with logos smaller than the size of your fist
- Shorts
- Chapstick and/or lip gloss (in non glass containers)
- Compacts with small mirrors
- Make-up in non-glass containers
- Asthma inhalers
- Cough drops
- Contact solution / eye drops smaller than 4 oz. (120mL)
- iPods
- Cell Phones
- Small Cameras
- Eye-liner pencils
- Pin Lanyards (Official Disney)
- Blankets
- Glow items (sticks, necklaces, bracelets)

Please note that failure to follow the guidelines may result in delayed admission and/or denial of admission to your Grad Nite event. Also, Disneyland® Resort Security has the right to refuse admission to anyone they deem not appropriately dressed for the event.
