I have scheduled a field trip to the Ronyon Museum of Paleontology in Escondido. This small, private museum is not open to the public, but conducts tours and educational programs for school groups.

The museum has thousands of fossils on display and offers a guided tour, video presentation, and hands-on workshop. The focus is earth science and paleontology. The curator's wife works with a homeschool program in Escondido, so he is familiar with the needs and abilities of homeschooling children and families.

During the workshop, children will prepare their own rock and mineral or fossil kit, complete with labels, which they take home with them. ***These are real specimens!***

- Who? 1st grade and up (Younger siblings may attend, but not participate. There is a patio outside if staying in the museum is too difficult.)
- How much? \$14.00 per participant. Transporting parents are free, additional adults are \$5.00 (though they are discouraged)

We are limited to 25 participants. I need to get a number to the museum by March 16th, but would not need payment until April 20th.
