
Enclosed please find our Foundation's 2010 scholarship application. This award is based entirely upon financial need. Each year we award about 60-80 scholarships in the amount of \$500-\$1000 in all areas of the County.

Applicants for this award will be given a very brief, informal interview at their school sites in March or April. Awards are reported to the scholarship counselors in time for senior awards ceremonies.

Please note that our application deadline is much earlier this year than in past years, so as to avoid having applicants' interviews conflict with end-of-year testing. This year applications must be postmarked by March 2nd, 2010.
