Showcase 2010: "A Time to Be a Star"

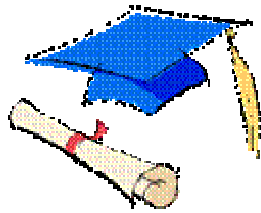
